Robing

Dress code

When you arrive at Curve the first thing to do is collect your graduation robes from Rehearsal Rooms 4 and 5 on the second floor. To keep crowds to a minimum guests cannot accompany students when they collect their robe, but can meet them in either Rehearsal Room 1 for photographs or on the ground floor in the café or bar area.

Graduands are expected to dress smartly. We reserve the right to refuse entry to the ceremony for anyone who is not suitably dressed. We highly recommend wearing comfortable shoes as there will be a lot of walking around the building.

Please remember to bring your robe order confirmation with you. It's not possible to collect your robe from Curve before the day of your ceremony.

Curve facilities

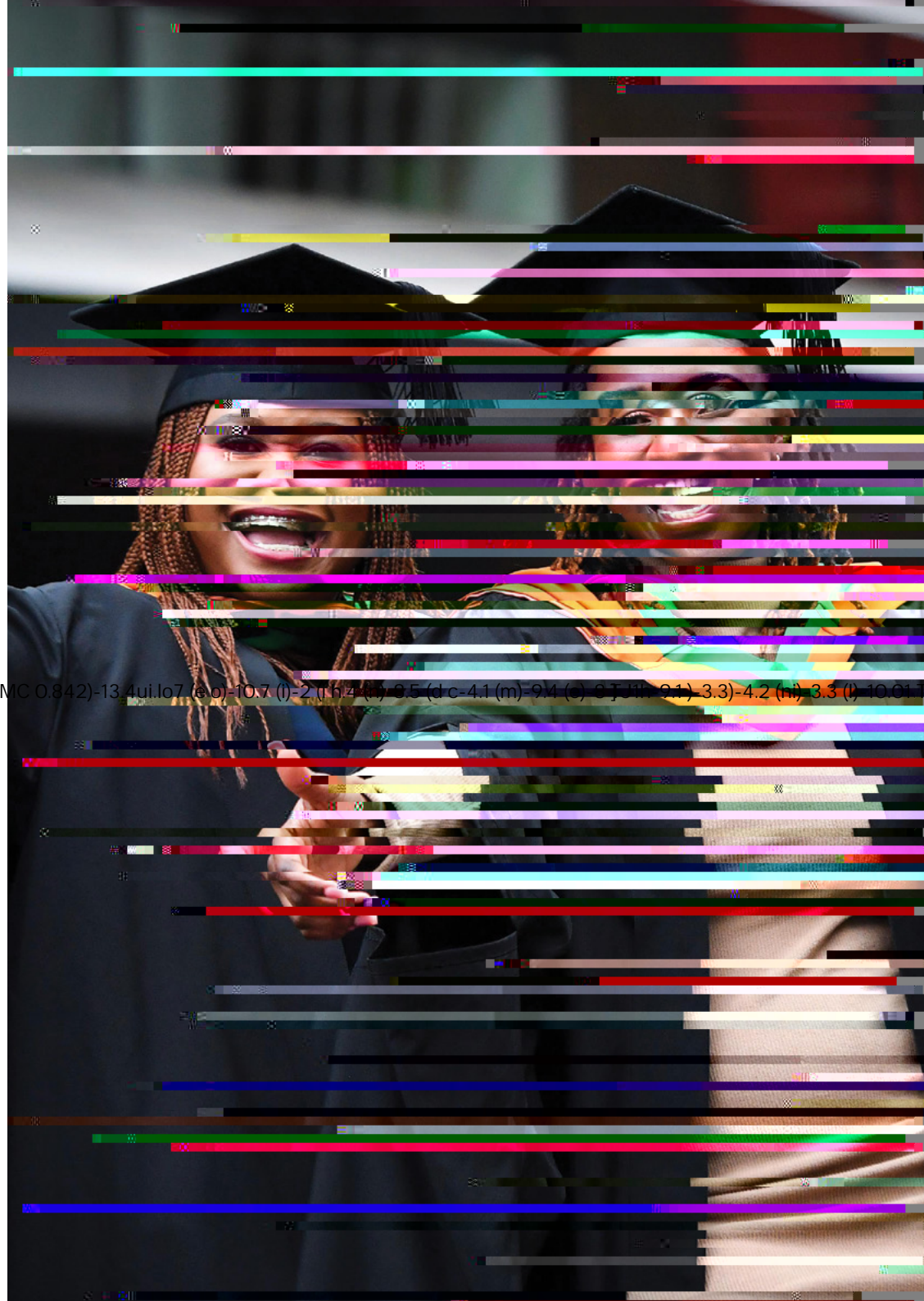
The two main entrances are on Halford Street and Rutland Street – there is level access from both entrances. Toilets are situated on all levels of the building and a 'buggy park' is available for prams and pushchairs, left at the owner's risk. Please note we cannot store large bags or luggage.

A prayer room is available on the first floor in the Mackintosh Dressing Room.

Please note, children under 16 years including children of graduating students, must be accompanied by an adult and cannot be left unattended.

Green Room Café

Leicester is a busy city and the centre can be quite congested so please allow time for this and plan your journey accordingly. The car parks nearest to Curve are:

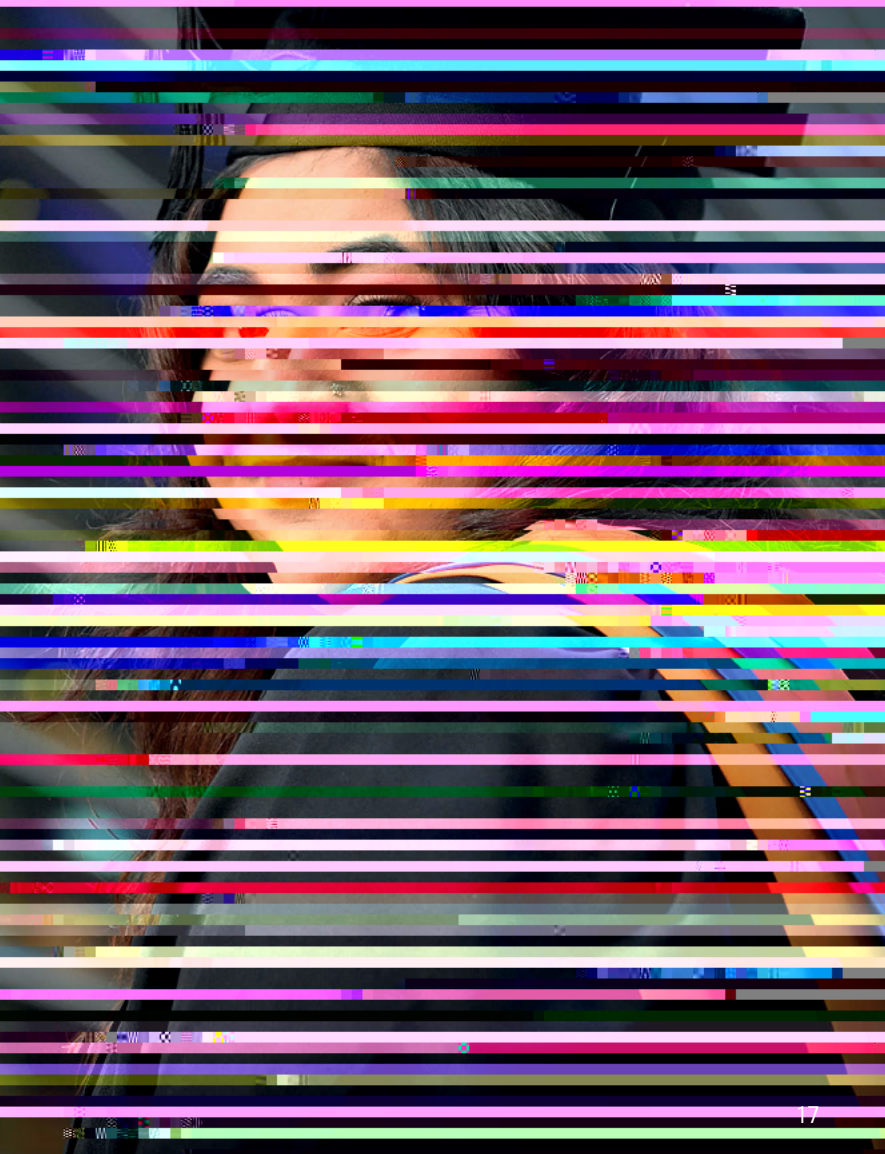
Rutland Centre Car Park Multi Storey (use satnav LE1 1TQ).
